## **Notes**

Trains from Stalybridge to Huddersfield depart at xx26 (all stops) & xx42 (express)

Trains from Huddersfield to Batley, Slaithwaite, Marsden & Greenfield are hourly

For those without a Metrocard, the best ticket to buy is a Metro bus and train dayover (a family one will cover two adults for £8) which is valid as far as Marsden. Anyone with a Metro senior permit would be best to buy a 35p single from Huddersfield to Batley and then a Batley Marsden return when they board the train in Batley.

Travel beyond Marsden is at the full adult fare. Tickets from Marsden to Stalybridge can be bought on the train at Marsden.
