| 49  | Black                    | Ilkley             | 3.7   | Mild         |                 | A dark and velvety mild made with chocolate and roasted malts to give a rich and satisfying flavour.                    |
| 50  | Pale                     | Ilkley             | 4.2   | Bitter       |                 | Crisp and pale with a refreshing citrus aroma.  |
| 51  | Midnight Bell            | Leeds              | 4.8   | Mild         |                 | A premium dark mild. Crystal and chocolate malts combine to give a full bodied, complex character.                      |
| 52  | JPA                      | Magpie             | 5.2   | Strong       |                 | Nose: mature hops, citrus fruit, taste: a balance of hops and malt in the mouth with a smooth, hoppy aftertaste         |
| 53  | Bloke From Hull          | Mallinsons         | 4.2   | Bitter       | *               | Blonde with hoppy nose, good citrus hop taste and finish. Dry hopped special.   |

| 59  | Bees Knees               | Nook               | 3.9   | Speciality   | *               | Well hopped bitter made with yorkshire honey and crystal malt.  |
| 60  | Best                     | Nook               | 4.2   | Bitter       |                 | A well balanced, smooth, easy drinking Best Bitter. Offering floral aromas balanced by a smooth malty palate.           |
| 61  | Blonde                   | Nook               | 4.5   | Speciality   |                 | English style wheat beer, citrusy overtones complement slightly biscuity palate.  |
| 62  | Oat Stout                | Nook               | 5.2   | Stout/Porter |                 | A full-flavoured Oaty stout with hints of liquorice and roasted flavours.   |
| 63  | Red                      | Nook               | 4.5   | Bitter       |                 | A deep chestnutty red ale featuring rich malty overtones but balanced by a fruity hop arom                              |
| 64  | Legend                   | Nottingham         | 4.0   | Bitter       |                 | Traditional, amber session ale with a flavoursome malt character and lively hoppy finish.                               |
| 65  | Matildas Revenge         | Opa Hays           | 4.3   | Bitter       |                 | Brewed as the house beer for the Kings Head Hotel in Beccles  |
| 66  | Oktoberfest              | Opa Hays           | 6.0   | Strong       | *               | Bavarian Style beer with a malty aroma and a hint of sweetness from the use of cara malt.                               |
| 67  | Quicksilver              | Ossett             | 5.0   | Strong       |                 | Pale and very bitter, this brew is a typical American-style IPA. Centennial hops give an intense citrus hop finish.     |
| 68  | Spellbound               | Ossett             | 4.3   | Bitter       |                 | Moderate bitterness is complemented by a citrus/spicy hop tanginess from Slovenian aroma hops.                          |

| 92  | Nelsons Revenge | Woodfordes  | 4.5   | Bitter     |                              | Rich and floral aromas, sweet Norfolk malts and a burst of 'citrus' hops embody this mouth-watering premium beer.    |

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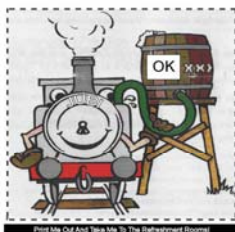
